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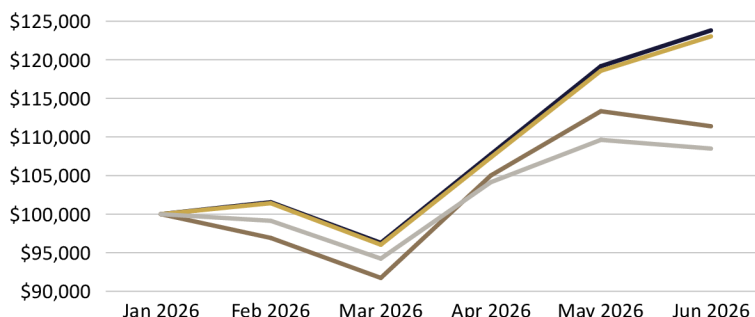

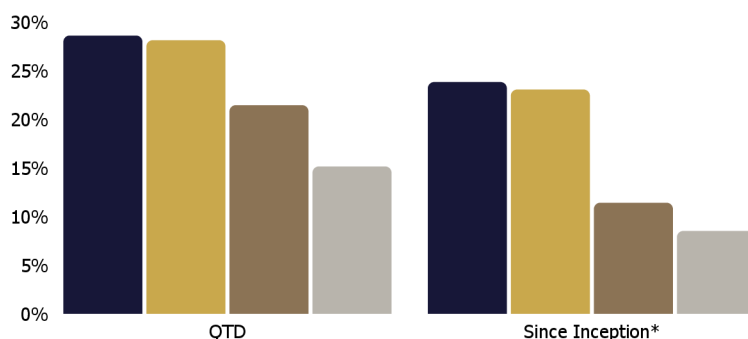
Growth of \$100,000

Keysight is a leading company in electronic design, emulation, and test — the instruments and software that engineers rely on to validate technology before it ships. Keysight today serves more than 30,000 customers across communications, semiconductors, aerospace and defense, automotive, and industrial markets.

We own Keysight as a "picks-and-shovels" stake in the next wave of innovation. It doesn't need to predict which company wins in AI, quantum, or 6G — every one of them has to design and validate its hardware, and Keysight sells the tools they all use to do it. In AI data centers, its KAI architecture and 1.6-terabit platforms validate the chips, optics, and interconnects behind AI fabrics. In quantum, its control systems now drive the world's largest commercial 1,000-qubit platform. It leads 6G research and supplies the test layer for autonomous-driving and advanced sensor systems — the same electronics foundation that physical AI and robotics will be built on. Keysight doesn't make the robot or the data center; it makes the precision tools the builders can't ship without.

That position shows up in the numbers. Keysight generated \$5.38 billion in revenue in fiscal 2025 and fiscal Q2 2026 revenue of \$1.72 billion, up 31% year-over-year, with gross margins above 72% and record free cash flow. It is a high-margin, durable franchise that scores strongly across our Excellence Evaluation: relentless innovation, exceptional fundamentals, and an infinite-game position that benefits no matter which platform ultimately wins.
